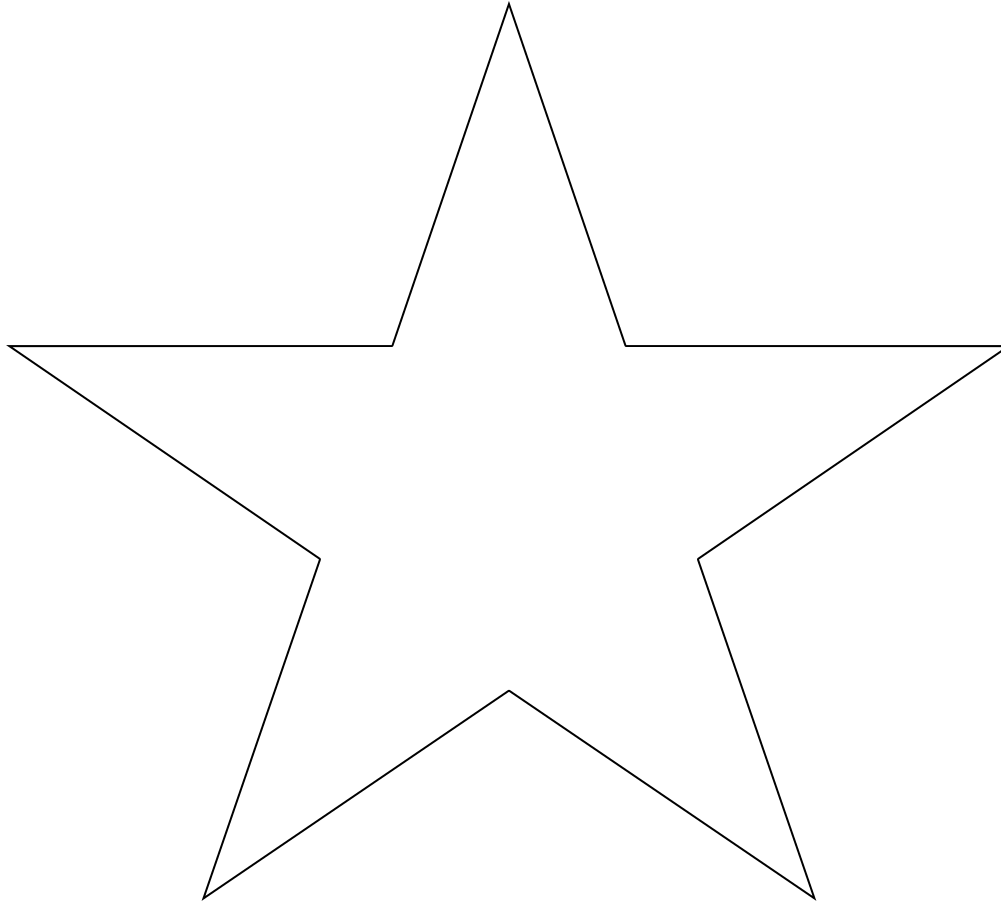




Homeside Activity: Shining Star
